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**SCHEDULE IR - CPS
INTERRUPTIBLE SERVICE RIDER**

AVAILABILITY

Available in conjunction with the Cooperative's Schedule LP for electric service furnished to snowmaking operations and their associated water pumping equipment. The full connected snowmaking load at these accounts is subject to be interrupted under the provisions of this rider. The rider is seasonal and shall only be effective from November to March of each winter season. Maximum kWh purchases available under this rider shall be 10,000,000 kWh per winter season. The effective term of the rider shall be 1 January 2005 through 31 March 2012. This rider provides Energy Charges which supersede the Energy Charges under Schedule LP, and an administrative charge for each account served hereunder. All other charges from Schedule LP are in full effect.

MONTHLY RATE

The monthly rate shall be:

Administrative Charge	\$75.00
Metering and Billing Charges	As indicated on Schedule LP
Distribution Charges	As indicated on Schedule LP
Energy Charges (November through February, for first 10 million kWh total)	
Non-interrupted Demand	\$6.367 per kW
Usage	\$0.02805 per kWh
Energy Charges (for all kWh over 10 million and for all energy in March)	
Usage	\$0.04536 per kWh
<i>(There will be no demand charge for energy sold under this section of the rate.)</i>	

Energy charges are subject to the Power Cost Adjustment Rider as filed under Rate Schedule C.

DEFINITIONS

(1) **Interruption Period**

The Cooperative may declare interruption periods of up to two consecutive hours on a maximum of fifteen occasions per month under this rider. The Cooperative shall give notice to the customer a minimum of one hour in advance of the requested interruption.



(2) **Non-interrupted Demand**

The maximum 15 minute demand measured in a month in which the customer does not interrupt operation for all Interruption Periods during that month. If load is interrupted for all Interruption Periods resulting in no hourly demand above 500 kW during Interruption Periods, Noninterrupted Demand shall be zero.

TERM OF SERVICE

The initial term of service provided hereunder shall be one year. The Cooperative reserves the right to modify or withdraw service hereunder should there be a change in the wholesale rates under which the Cooperative purchases power for electric service furnished hereunder.
